

Basic Provisions

The dental plan benefits are divided into three categories - Diagnostic and Preventive Services, Routine and Restorative Services, and Major Restorative Services and Orthodontic Treatment. The maximum benefit for each procedure will be the actual cost charged to the extent that the charge does not exceed Usual, Customary and Reasonable (UCR). **There is a maximum benefit of \$1,500.00 per covered individual per calendar year for Diagnostic and Preventive, Routine and Restorative and Major Restorative Services. There is a \$1,500.00 lifetime maximum for Orthodontic Services.**

Diagnostic and Preventive Services - Payable at 100% of UCR

- Routine oral examination - one every 6 months
- X-rays - limitations apply, see certificate
- Cleaning of teeth - one every 6 months
- Topical fluoride applications-one every 12 months
-only for unmarried dependent children under age 19

Routine and Restorative Services - Payable at 80% of UCR

- Emergency treatment for relief of pain
- Fillings
- Extractions
- Space maintainers for children under age 14
- Topical application of sealants for children under age 15
- Anesthesia
- Other basic repair work

Major Restorative Services - Payable at 50% of UCR

- Endodontics
- Non-surgical Periodontics
- Surgical Periodontics
- Bridges
- Dentures
- Cast Restorations
- Crowns

Orthodontic Treatment – Payable at 50% of UCR

- No deductible
- Lifetime maximum of \$1,500.00 per person
- Available only to dependent children up to age 19
